Transfer from child-related volunteering to child-related paid employment


If a Volunteer 'V' card holder proposes to, or commences a paid child-related activity with your organisation, they must transfer their volunteer 'V' card to a paid 'P' card by submitting 'Volunteer to paid employment transfer form' available from our website.

Changes in police information (criminal history)

Blue Card Services receive daily updates of changes in police information for current blue card applicants and card holders from Queensland Police. If you are charged with, or convicted of, an offence you are required to advise your child-related organisation (if you are student, volunteer, or paid employee) or Blue Card Services (if you are business operator or self-employed). Information on how to notify of the change and the relevant form is available from our website.
